“The book by ICOMOS Italy and ICOMOS ISCEC to celebrate Matera capital of culture 2019”

The very interesting Congress carries out in Matera (11th-15th of December 2018) to celebrate the 25° Anniversary of the inscription of the *lucana* historical town and the District “I Sassi” in the Heritage of the Humanity of the UNESCO List of World Heritage in the WHL (1993), especially in the 2018: European Year of Cultural Heritage.

The Congress has been coordinated by architect Pietro Laureano ,president of ICOMOS Italy 2016-2019 and the principal scientific author of the Matera inscription in the WHL in 1993 and by prof. arch. Luigi Fusco Girard, vice-president of ICOMOS Italy and President of ICOMOS ISCEC. The Program and the aim of this Congress was to enhance the efforts made to set off the today town since 25 years from the inscription in the UNESCO World Heritage List : . **Matera. The culture of the valorization: balance and perspectives.** (fig.1).

Subsequently for the strong interest of the Italian and European presentations at the different sections of the congress the ICOMOS Director Council has decided to publish all the documentation written, graphic and photographic discussed regarding the exceptional historical town of Matera, located in the South of Italy in the Region Basilicata.

After a long excursus and surpassed all the difficulties, principally economic, now it is possible to announce the new publication edited by Luigi Fusco Girard with Martina Bosone and Claudia Trillo with the Neapolitan editor Giannini in this month of May 2020.

The title of the volume is a synthesis of the idea basis of the Congress strictly related to the Matera today identity:

“Matera, città del sistema ecologico uomo/società/natura: il ruolo della cultura per la rigenerazione del sistema urbano territoriale”

(Matera, city of ecological system man/society/nature: the cultural role for the urban territorial system regeneration)

The volume in Italian and English languages found on the theme that The European Year of Cultural Heritage 2019 has had Matera as European Capital of Culture and it proposes for the revitalization of historical towns towards the integration of beauty, economy and fairness, as Matera has made in the last 10 years.

Matera is in fact the real expression of “an another culture” in contrast with the other big cities appointed as European capitals. These capital Cities have rich monuments and very famous sites and have had for the nomination a lot of finances’ ability jointly to the proposals of millionaire investments. This action is in contrast with the Southern Italy ancient city has suggested; ancient town, named by Pietro Laureano “Giardino di pietre” in his 1992 famous book.

In the period of only two generations Matera has realized the restoration and the revitalization of the ancient historical quarter “I Sassi”, with the return of their inhabitants in their ancient houses. This is the extraordinary experience of a whole city, from the complete abandonment of the built up area and the return in the urban life today.

It is important to underline regarding Matera European 2019 capital that the conservation of the physical signs of the Medieval urban centre become the safeguard of the intangible heritage, recover of its identity and cultural-spiritual values.
